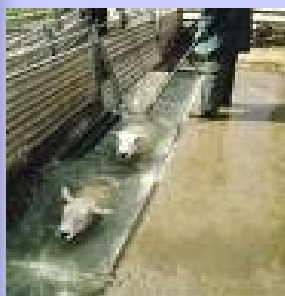


On DVD : The Financial Risks & Opportunities in Contaminated Properties
